- **Changes to the School Day from September 2026**

As you will be aware, Surrey County Council has determined that their local authority-maintained schools should move to a two-week half term in October 2026. The Lumen Learning Trust is not required to follow the local authority's decision about term dates, however we have chosen to do so, because we feel to do otherwise may negatively impact our families with children in our feeder secondary schools. Therefore, and as previously communicated, the half term in Autumn 2026 will be a two-week half term (**Oct 19th to 30th 2026**).

To make up for the learning time that will be lost during the additional holiday week, the trust has asked schools to adjust the timings of their school day, adding 10 mins of learning time every day. Southfield Park has decided that we will be reducing the length of our soft start in the mornings by 5 minutes, meaning that children can arrive at school between **8:35am and 8:45am** with registers taken at **8:45am**. We will also be shortening lunchtime by 5 minutes. These changes to the school day will start in September 2026.

- **Working Collaboratively**

One of the prime reasons that the school joined the Lumen Learning Trust was to have the benefit of working collaboratively with like-minded schools. We are pleased to say that the opportunities for shared work and learning are already having an impact.

In the last couple of weeks, Mrs Foley and I have been out working in meetings and workshops with Heads, Deputies and Inclusion Leads. In the next few weeks, our Year 3 team are out at Riverbridge Primary School working with their year group colleagues, and our Reception team are out visiting other EYFS settings. Collaboration is important at all levels, and our governors have also been invited to work with the other governors in the Trust in exploring the complex priorities involved when meeting the needs of individual children in a mainstream classroom environment.

Our local links are still very important to us, and next week our teachers will all be working on writing moderation with their year group colleagues from our local cluster of schools in Epsom and Ewell.

● Admission arrangements for Southfield Park September 2027

Following the 6-week consultation which took place from Friday 28th November 2025 to Friday 9th January 2026 we confirm that the admission arrangements for Southfield Park Primary School were determined by Lumen Learning Trust Directors on 30th January 2026.

As part of the determination the following changes have been applied:

- Removal of 'Exceptional/social medical need' as a criterion within the admission arrangements.
- Removal of 'Children living in the defined catchment area of the school' as a criterion within the admission arrangements.

● How do we help your child at school?

We are pleased to be working in partnership with the PINs Project to support our families and strengthen home-school relationships.

As part of this, we will be hosting a coffee morning on **Friday 27th February, 9-10am**. This will be a relaxed and welcoming opportunity for parents and carers to share their voice, ask questions and learn more about how we support children in school. You do not need to come for the full hour, but are welcome to pop in between 9 and 10 am.

The session will be set up as a fair-style event, with a variety of tables showcasing the different areas of support available in school. These will include behaviour support, emotional regulation, wellbeing, and information about wider services we work with to support children and families. There will be time for informal discussion, to meet staff involved in supporting children day to day, and to explore the support on offer at your own pace. We hope you can join us for a cup of coffee and a conversation – your views and experiences are important to us.

- **Careers Week – 9th–13th February**

We are very excited to be celebrating Careers Week from 9th–13th February! This will be a fantastic opportunity for children to think about the world of work and begin to explore their own ambitions for the future.

The week will have a particular focus in Years 3–6, where children will be learning about how the workplace has changed over time and discovering the wide range of careers available today. We are also delighted to be welcoming parent volunteers into school to talk about their jobs and career journeys – a huge thank you to everyone who has already volunteered to support this.

Importantly, all children across the school, including KS1, will be taking part by completing a piece of work linked to their future aspirations. To finish the week, on Friday 13th February, children are invited to wear an accessory that gives a clue about their dream future career, ready for their class to guess. The children should still wear their school uniform and please ensure that any accessories are not anything too precious. We can't wait to see the brilliant ideas they come up with!

- **Team Teach Positive Touch Training**

This week has seen another successful staff training session for some of our team with Team Teach. Positive Touch training is a substantial piece of training that all of our staff receive. It is evidence-based training which puts the individual at the centre of every decision and enables the team to confidently de-escalate situations and reduce the need for physical intervention.

- **Inclusion Review next week**

The school is committed to inclusive practice and has commissioned an Inclusion Review with Surrey County Council, which will be taking place next week. This will be a chance to do a deep dive into our SEND provision, from classroom practice to financial planning, and will highlight our successes as well as identifying growth opportunities.

- **Communication with School - Graduated approach**

Please do talk to us if you are concerned about your child. We encourage parents to share worries early, before they grow into bigger concerns. You can speak to a member of staff at the door, phone the school, or email the office.

The school office inbox is monitored daily, and emails are forwarded to the appropriate members of staff. All correspondence is treated confidentially and logged on our safeguarding and pastoral system. We aim to respond within a day or two, depending on urgency.

As the Headteacher, I have overall oversight, but I am not always the most appropriate person to respond initially. Early concerns are usually best managed by your child's class teacher, who knows your child's day-to-day provision best. If a concern needs to be escalated, this will normally move from the class teacher to the phase leader. If the concern relates to SEND, it may then be supported by the Inclusion Lead or another member of the Senior Leadership Team. For wider concerns, escalation may involve the Deputy Headteacher or Headteacher as appropriate. In addition, our pastoral leads are available to offer support with emotional wellbeing, behaviour, attendance or family circumstances.

This graduated approach helps ensure concerns are addressed promptly, consistently and by the staff best placed to support your child.

Small problems can become much larger in the minds of children if left and not dealt with. Please support us by reminding your child that they must talk to a member of staff if something makes them unhappy during the school day.

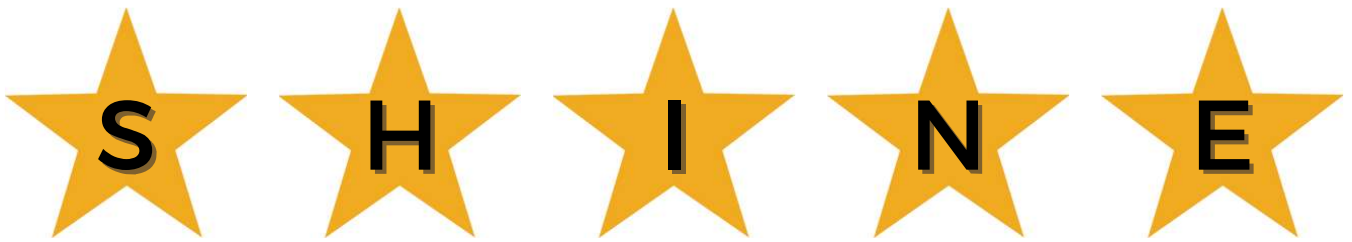
Doors open at 7:30pm for an 8pm start.

● Attendance & Fixed Penalty Notices

If families take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:

- If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19th August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19th August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996. Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.

Requests for exceptional leave need to be submitted using the form on our website, at least 2 weeks before the date being requested. All other exceptional leave will or will not be authorised on a case by case basis. A child's attendance and previous requests for leave will always be considered when making a decision.

Remember to bring your drinks, snacks (nut-free), £1 coins and thinking caps....or beautifully useless facts you've been saving!

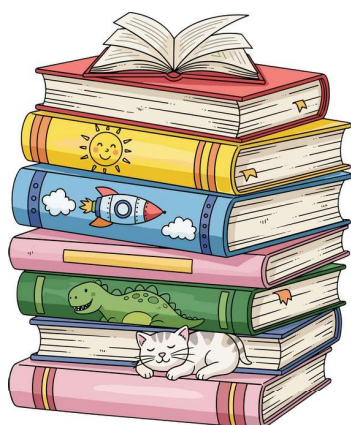


● Unwanted Books
