- **Reminder: Fidgets**

Our school policy is that children will be provided with regulation devices (sometimes known as fidgets) if they are deemed to be useful by staff and external professionals. Children are not permitted to bring fidgets and toys in from home and these will be removed so that they are not a distraction for your child and rest of the children in the class. Please help us by ensuring that your child is not bringing items into school which we then have to remove, as this can be upsetting for children and can cause conflict and dysregulation. If you are unsure whether a device might be useful for your child, please talk to your child's teacher who will be pleased to advise.

- **Staff News**

I am very pleased to say that we have two new members of support staff joining us in September. A very warm welcome to Mrs Jo Zygiert-Kan and Mrs Ayesha Javed who will be joining our KS2 Team.

- **Reception 2026 Induction**

Next week, our new Reception children, parents and carers will be joining us and we would like to extend a very warm Southfield Park welcome to them. On Thursday 18th June at 6pm, we will be holding our parent and carers information session, and on Friday 19th June the children will be joining us for their Teddy Bears Picnic. Our staff have also started their visits to nurseries so that we can meet the children and gather useful transition information.

- **Bikeability Success!**

Alongside learning their lines and songs for our upcoming Lion King production, some of our Year 6 children have also been juggling their Bikeability course this week. The children began by practising their skills on the playground on Monday before progressing to the local roads from Tuesday onwards.

Throughout the course, the children have been developing essential cycling skills, including looking, signalling and manoeuvring safely in real traffic situations. They have shown excellent listening skills, maturity and responsibility while cycling on the main roads.

We are incredibly proud of how well they have represented our school and the positive attitude they have shown throughout the week. We hope they will use the knowledge and confidence they have gained to cycle safely to and from school in the future. Well done to everyone who took part!

● Attendance & Fixed Penalty Notices

If families take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:

- If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19th August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19th August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996. Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.

Requests for exceptional leave need to be submitted using the form on our website, at least 2 weeks before the date being requested. All other exceptional leave will or will not be authorised on a case by case basis. A child's attendance and previous requests for leave will always be considered when making a decision.

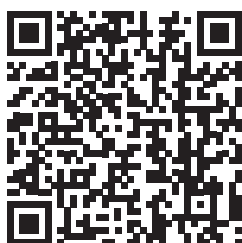

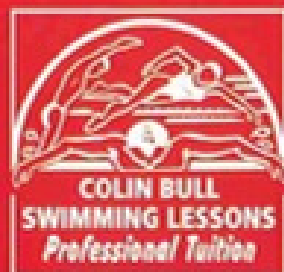
