Creative Arts Week

What an exciting Creative Arts Week we have had in Reception! The children have been bursting with creativity, starting with making headbands and shakers as they enthusiastically prepare for the upcoming parade. We also explored how music can inspire art, creating beautiful "musical drawings".



The children did a fantastic job comparing the different marks they made while listening to calm versus dramatic music. A huge highlight of the week was our LAMDA workshop, where the children used their imaginations to transform everyday socks into wonderful puppets. We also put our rhythm to the test during a high-energy drumming workshop, where everyone tried incredibly hard to keep in time as a whole class. Finally, the children rolled up their sleeves to sculpt and shape their very own clay pots. It has been a joyful week full of rhythm, art, and imagination!

Year 1 have had so much fun this week! We started the week by getting messy with some giant mark making to music. We then got ourselves into groups to form our own bands in preparation for our music festival on Friday. We used junk modelling to create our own microphones, drums, guitars and shakers, before decorating them. We can't wait to perform our songs to the rest of our class! On Tuesday we learnt about Leanne Beetham, a mouth artist, and used her artwork to complete half of a drawing by sketching. Wednesday started with a BOOM as we got to experience a drumming workshop and we were also visited by LAMDA and Charmile where we got to put our performing skills into action! Our creative flair continued with some watercolour painting, polystyrene printing and t-shirt decorating. We are looking forward to showing off some of our creations at the parade next Monday!



Year 2

Year 2 had a fantastic time taking part in an exciting street dance workshop one afternoon this week! The children showed great enthusiasm, learnt some brilliant new moves, and worked together to create energetic routines. It was wonderful to see their confidence and creativity shine through!

Year 3

Year 3 have had a fantastic Creative Arts Week! Despite the hot weather, the children have thrown themselves into every activity with enthusiasm and creativity. We have been sketching, painting, sewing and drumming our way through the week! On Tuesday, we took a short walk to The Horton, where the children enjoyed a fantastic LAMDA workshop. They explored a range of cartoons through freeze-frame activities, demonstrating excellent teamwork and imagination. 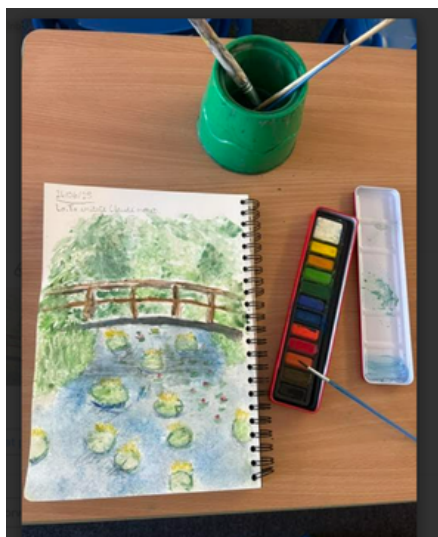
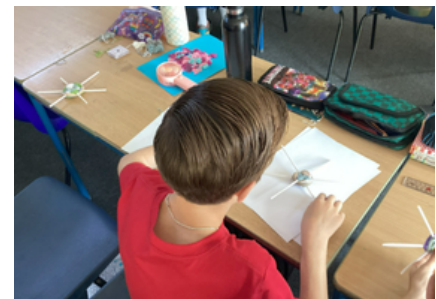


Year 4 have enjoyed our Creative Arts Week with a range of activities including Drama workshops, watercolour landscape painting, clay pot creations, Eduthing stop motion animations, collaborative display work and still life drawing in the style Morandi all mixed in with water fights and ice-pops.

Year 5 had a fantastic time during Creative Arts Week, taking part in a variety of exciting and creative activities. The children created beautiful blossom artwork, prepared colourful decorations and props for the school parade, and developed their weaving skills during a workshop with Mrs Robinson. They also enjoyed creating nature-inspired art with Mrs Root and took part in an engaging LAMDA drama workshop at Horton, where they explored drama techniques through fun and interactive activities. Although the extreme heat meant we were unable to visit Hogsmill as planned, the children explored the area by watching a video and used it as inspiration to create their own beautiful landscape artwork. It was a wonderful week filled with creativity, collaboration and imagination, and the children were incredibly proud of everything they achieved.



Year 6 has had a fantastic and busy Creative Arts Week! We enjoyed an exciting LAMDA workshop at the Horton, where we learnt performance combat techniques and developed our acting skills through drama activities. Back at school, we have been creating our own Monet-inspired artwork in preparation for our upcoming visit to the National Gallery in London next week. The children have explored colour, texture and Impressionist techniques to produce some beautiful pieces. We also took part in a stop-motion animation workshop using iPads, where the children worked creatively to bring their ideas to life through digital storytelling and animation. In addition, we have been working hard on preparations for our end-of-year celebrations, creating props for our parade and rehearsing for our Year 6 production. The school has been filled with the sounds of singing, performing and lots of creativity as the children have enthusiastically embraced every opportunity to showcase their talents. We are incredibly proud of the enthusiasm, teamwork and creativity Year 6 have shown throughout the week!

Autumn Term 2026

● Attendance & Fixed Penalty Notices

If families take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:

- If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19th August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19th August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996. Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.

Requests for exceptional leave need to be submitted using the form on our website, at least 2 weeks before the date being requested. All other exceptional leave will or will not be authorised on a case by case basis. A child's attendance and previous requests for leave will always be considered when making a decision.
