If you are ever in any doubt about how the funds raised by the Friends benefit the school, here are just two wonderful examples from this term.

Firstly, the Friends fully funded all of the workshops, events and materials for Creative Arts Week, enabling every child to enjoy an inspiring week full of creativity, performance and artistic opportunities.

We are also delighted to announce that our Regulation Zone is now installed and open. The Friends generously donated the substantial funds needed to create this wonderful space, providing children with a calm, welcoming environment where they can regulate their emotions or spend time co-regulating with a trusted adult whenever they need to. This invaluable addition will help children return to learning feeling settled and ready to succeed, while reducing the impact on learning for everyone.

Our children are currently deciding what to call this new room, so watch this space for their final decision!



● **Keep Going, Year 6!**

Our Year 6 children continue to impress us and prove that they are more than ready for their move to secondary school. This week, they have spent time visiting their new schools and have returned full of enthusiasm and excitement about the next stage of their journey. Today, they are in London visiting the National Gallery, enjoying one final educational visit together before the end of the year. It has been lovely to see the new leavers' hoodies this week but Year 6, please leave them safe at home next week when temperatures soar again.

We have heard from the DfE that SATs results have been delayed and will now be released on 16th July.

Next week, the children will perform *The Lion King* on Tuesday and Wednesday at 6.00 pm and, if rehearsals are anything to go by, we are all in for a real treat! By the time Friday arrives, they will certainly have earned their well-deserved reward day at Chessington.

Year 6 parents, please don't forget that the children will also be holding their Leavers' Assembly for parents on Friday 17 July at 9.00 am. We hope you will be able to join us as we celebrate everything they have achieved during their time at Southfield Park.



As we get closer to our Year 6 production performance on Tuesday 7th July and Wednesday 8th July, tickets are now available for the whole community via the school office. We are incredibly excited to share this spectacular production and look forward to welcoming audiences to support our talented Year 6 performers.

- **Year 6 STEM Workshop**

On Friday 26th June, Year 6 took part in an exciting STEM workshop led by the Royal Academy of Engineering. Working in small groups, the children tackled a range of hands-on engineering challenges, including programming a desert robot using sensors, designing and building a bridge with a pulley system, using a compass and sonar sensors to detect objects underwater, and constructing a complex Antarctic dome shelter using hexagons and pentagons. The workshop encouraged teamwork, problem-solving and creative thinking, while giving the children a real insight into the work of engineers. They thoroughly enjoyed the practical activities and had the opportunity to ask questions about careers in engineering. It was a fantastic experience, and we hope it has inspired some of our Year 6 pupils to consider a future in engineering!

● Attendance & Fixed Penalty Notices

If families take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:

- If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19th August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19th August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996. Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.

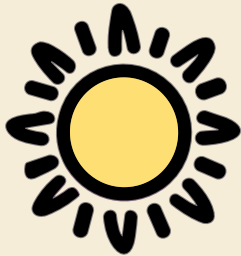

All other exceptional leave will or will not be authorised on a case by case basis. A child's attendance and previous requests for leave will always be considered when making a decision.

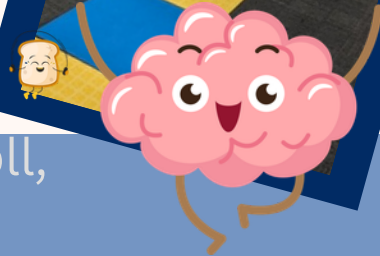

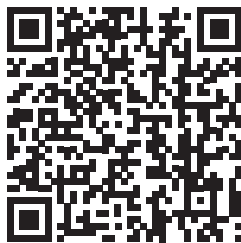
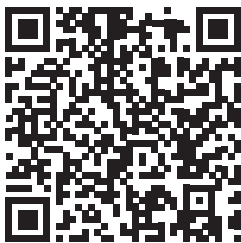

These sessions focus on addressing anxiety, worries, building resilience and celebrating each child's strengths.

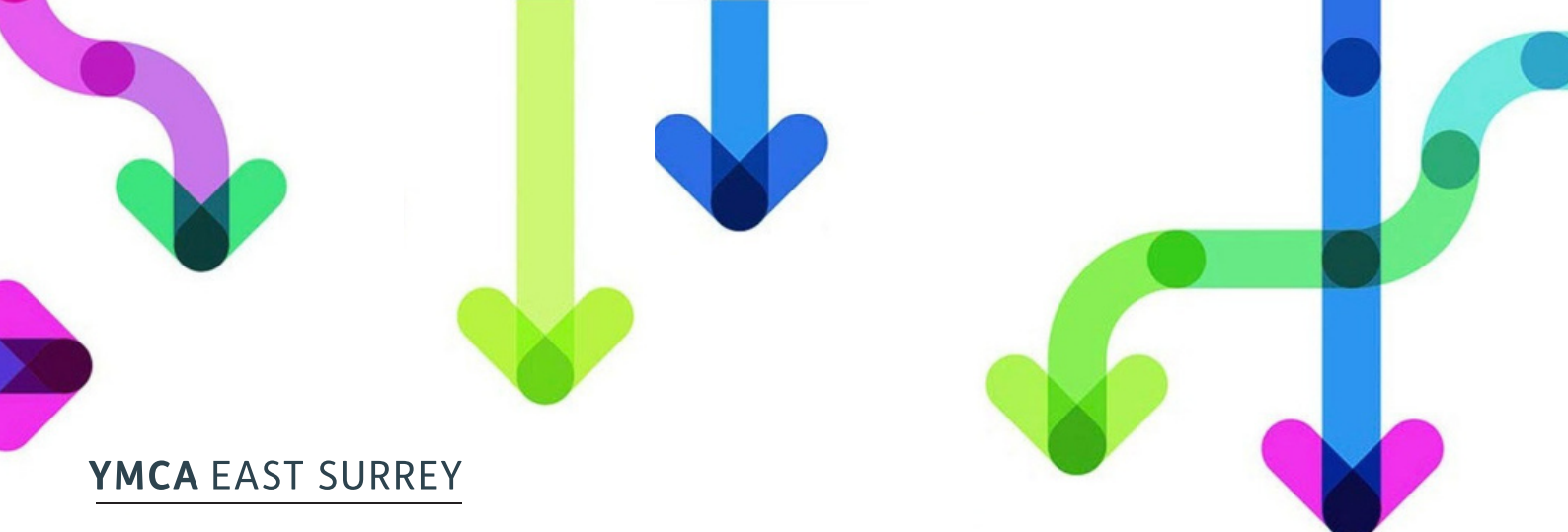

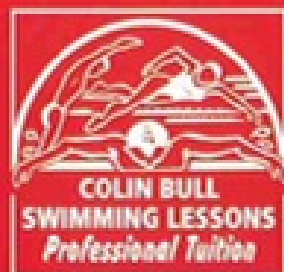
