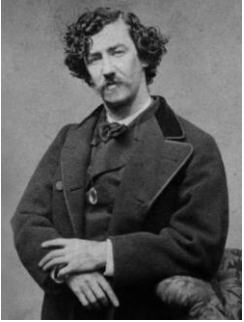


Seascapes

Key Vocabulary

Seascape	A picture or view of the sea.
Horizon	The line that separates earth from sky.
Watercolours	A type of paint you add water to make a paler colour.
Wash	Using a pale, watery colour over the whole page.
Texture	What things are made of and how they feel.
Surface	The top layer or something.
