

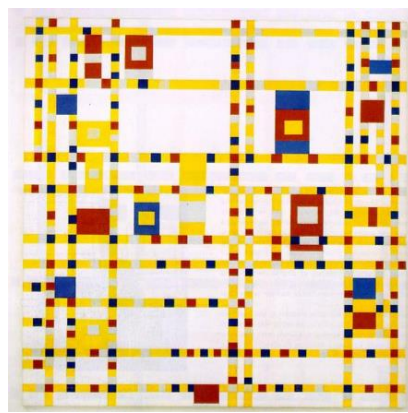
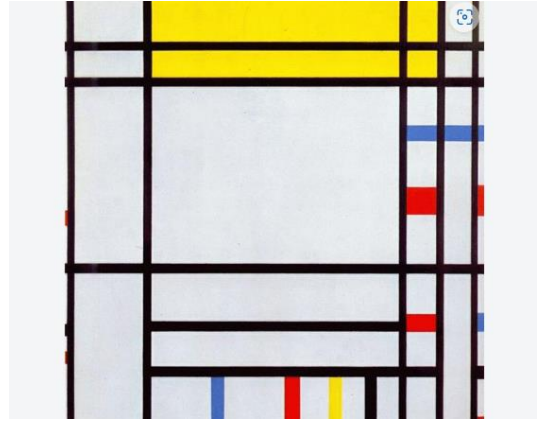
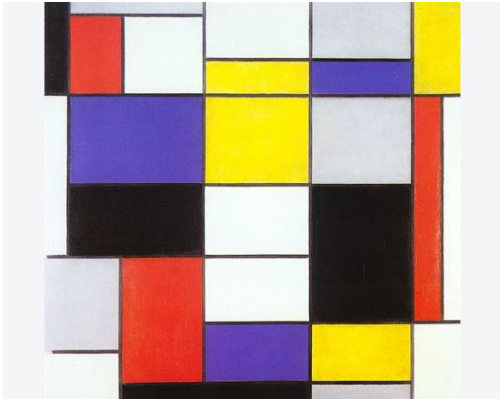

- He was a Dutch artist.

- He was best known for his abstract paintings.
- He often used primary colours and straight lines.
