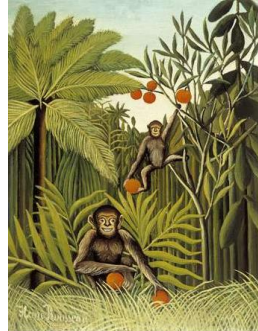
Who is Henri Rousseau?

- Rousseau was born in 1844 in France.
- He taught himself to paint in his spare time and started displaying his work at galleries in 1886.
- His most famous paintings were scenes from the jungle, showing different animals and plants.

His inspirations were jungle scenes.

Key Vocabulary

Pattern	A decorative design that is repeated.
Relief Print	The printing surface is cut away so that the image alone appears raised on the surface.
Monoprint	A single print taken from a design created from printing ink.
Polystyrene	A light plastic used for printing.
