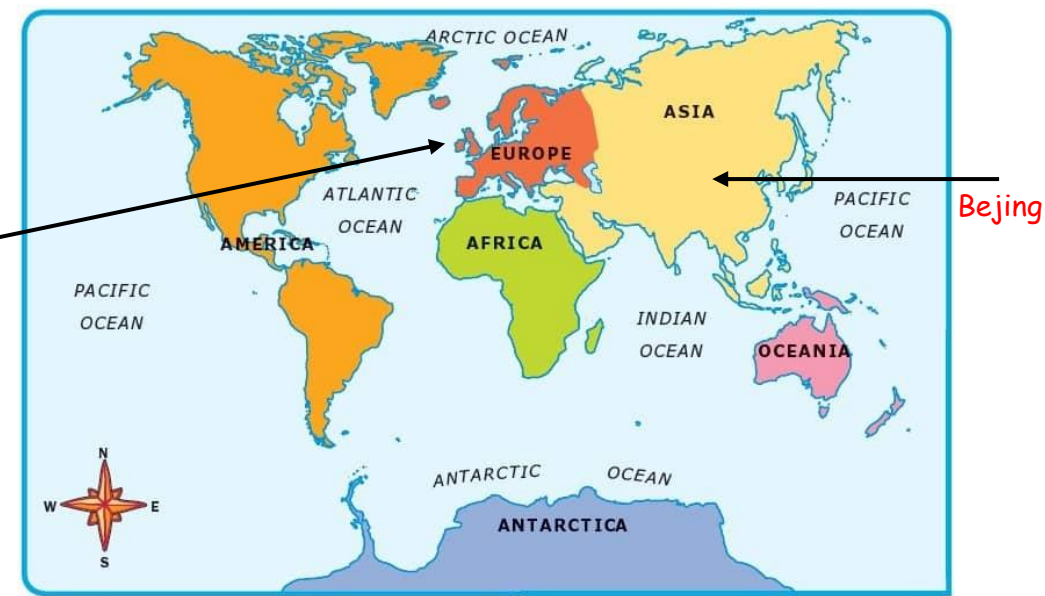


Year 2 Autumn Term - Where in the world are we?

Human geography	Studies how people and environments have an effect on each other.

Shop	A place that sells things for people to buy.
Physical geography	The study of landscapes and environments.
Physical features	Things you can see on the Earth's surface that have been formed by nature.
