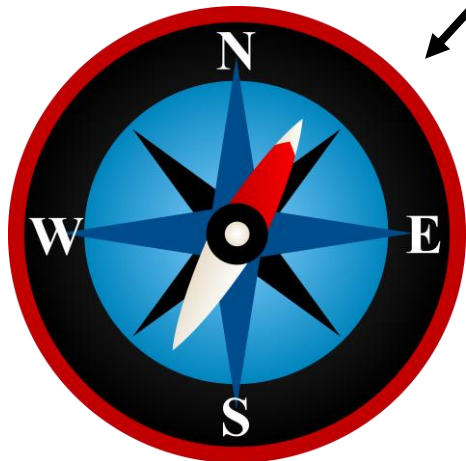
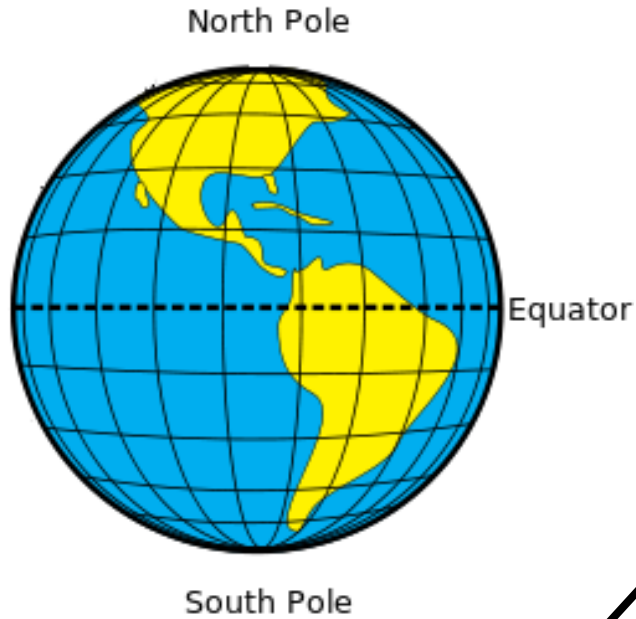

Vocabulary	
Vegetation	Vegetation means the plant life of an area or the plant community. It means all ground cover by plants.
Soil	A mixture of minerals and organic material that covers much of Earth's surface.
Equator	An imaginary line that goes around the middle of the Earth.
Polar	Relating to the North or South Pole.
Desert	A place with not a lot of rain or vegetation.
Compass	A tool for finding direction.
North	A compass point opposite to South.
South	A compass point opposite to North.
East	A compass point opposite to West.
West	A compass point opposite to East.
Near	A short distance away.
Far	A great distance away.
Left	On your left hand side.
Right	On your right hand side.
Climate	What the weather is like in a place.
