- **Uniform changes from September**



Children may wear either black school shoes or black plain trainers. If trainers are worn to school they must have a black sole and must not have coloured logos, details or stitching. If children are not wearing the correct uniform, we will make contact with parents and carers to ask them to bring in the correct items.



Children who need adaptations to our uniform will be agreed by our SENDCo Emily Stokes. Parents can make contact through the office.



- **Changes to the school day from September**

This is a reminder that our school day is changing slightly in September, with our soft start drop off now being between 8:35 and 8:45. Registers will be taken at 8:50 and children will be marked as late if they arrive in the classroom later than 8:50. Lessons will start promptly after registers are taken.

Dogs at pick up and drop off

We had an incident at drop off this morning where a child arrived distressed after an incident with an dog that was not on a lead outside the gates. All dogs that are accompanying children to and from school must be kept on a short lead at all times, should not enter the school grounds, and if they are left unattended, they must not be secured to the areas of the gates near children's entry points. We would appreciate dog owners support with this.



- **Little Wandle reading books**



Before the end of term, we'd be grateful if you could have a good look around at home for any Little Wandle reading books. If you find any, please return them to school as soon as possible so they can be checked, organised and ready for children to enjoy in the new academic year.

School Meals Update: Keep an Eye on Your Inbox!

Following up on our exciting news about our new school caterer, Dolce Ltd, and the SchoolGrid portal launching this September, we wanted to give you a quick heads-up to look out for further information.

As mentioned, you don't need to take any action just yet. However, behind the scenes, we are preparing to share the priority 1 contact email addresses with SchoolGrid so your accounts can be created.

What to look out for next:

- **School Office:** will be sending an email containing a Welcome letter from Dolce along with detailed instructions to setting up your school grid account. All parents must activate a school grid account to enable your child to receive a school dinner from 1 st September 26.
- **The Activation Email:** coming next week, you will receive an email directly from SchoolGrid containing your unique activation link and step-by-step instructions.
- **Action Required:** Please ensure you look out for this email and complete the setup before the start of term in September so you can easily pre-order meals, manage payments, and log crucial allergen information.

.If you have any urgent questions in the meantime, please feel free to contact the school office.

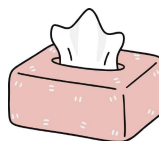

● Attendance & Fixed Penalty Notices

If families take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:

- If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19th August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19th August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996. Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.

Requests for exceptional leave need to be submitted using the form on our website, at least 2 weeks before the date being requested. All other exceptional leave will or will not be authorised on a case by case basis. A child's attendance and previous requests for leave will always be considered when making a decision.
