Back to School: Thursday 4th September

Please do use the Summer Holidays to prepare your children for their return in September. We have been very understanding with uniform expectations over the last few weeks in the hot weather, and as school shoes have come to the end of their life.

Please ensure that children are back in full uniform in the Autumn Term.

Uniform changes from September



Children may wear either black school shoes or black plain trainers. If trainers are worn to school they must have a black sole and must not have coloured logos, details or stitching. If children are not wearing the correct uniform, we will make contact with parents and carers to ask them to bring in the correct items.



Children who need adaptations to our uniform will be agreed by our SENDCo Emily Stokes. Parents can make contact through the office.

- Items highlighted in purple are available only from Schoolwear Inc. Other uniform items are available from Schoolwear Inc, but may also be purchased from the high street if you prefer.

The school aims to support sustainability of school uniform by holding regular pre-loved sales throughout the school year. These are kindly managed by our 'Friends'.

It is a Lumen Learning Trust stipulation that children must not wear earrings while taking part in PE lessons. Members of staff will not be expected to remove earrings on behalf of children so a child must be able to remove their earrings independently or alternatively the earrings are removed before they come to school. This includes children with newly pierced ears; the duration of the lesson is not long enough to allow piercings to close over. We will not allow children to take part in lessons with plasters covering earrings so it is imperative that children learn to remove/insert earrings themselves.

Jewellery is not allowed except for watches and small stud earrings (worn at the owner's own risk).

We also have a policy of no make-up or nail varnish. Hair should not cover children's eyes as this can affect learning. Long hair should be tied up.

Please clearly name all items of your child's property - if these are mislaid, they are much more likely to be returned. Any named items found in school will be returned to your child. Unnamed property will be sustainably disposed of or entered into pre-loved uniform sales periodically at the school's discretion.

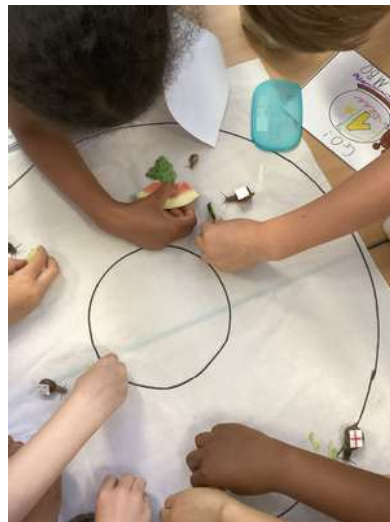

● Attendance & Fixed Penalty Notices

If families take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:

- If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19th August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19th August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
- If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996. Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.

Requests for exceptional leave need to be submitted using the form on our website, at least 2 weeks before the date being requested. All other exceptional leave will or will not be authorised on a case by case basis. A child's attendance and previous requests for leave will always be considered when making a decision.
