Dear Families,

We hope you all had a lovely, restful break over Easter and are ready for the fantastic term ahead! Our classrooms will be as busy as ever this term. We will continue daily learning in English and Maths as well as a fitting in lots of fun learning from the wider curriculum: learning about plants in Science, pitch in Music, the coast in Geography, Judaism (Shabbat) in RE and clay tiles in Art!

The Summer term is also a great chance for children to develop the children's independence and prepare for the transition to Year Two. Please encourage the children to look after their own bags and be responsible for their belongings such as jumpers, cardigans and water bottles. To help with this, please make sure everything is clearly labelled as we regularly accumulate a large amount of unnamed clothing.

These are some of the key skills we will be focusing on over the Summer Term:

- Reading fluently and recognising key words in a text (Little Wandle books will continue to come home for the weekend)
- Spelling year one common exception words correctly
- Consistently using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
- Using 'and' to join sentences
- Learning addition and subtraction facts
- Rapidly recalling number bonds to 20 and the related subtraction facts
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Simple multiplication and division



Our PE days this term are Monday (outdoor) and Thursday (indoor)

Please ensure they have the correct kit, which is suitable for the warmer weather. This should be:

- A white t-shirt
- Navy blue shorts
- Socks (additional to the pair they wear to school)
- Trainers (ideally Velcro)

Earrings **must** be removed for PE (which is a Surrey requirement) therefore please ensure your child can remove them themselves or that they do not wear them to school on PE days.



As the weather gets warmer, it is important that your child brings a sun hat with them to school and they wear sun cream when needed so they can enjoy the sun safely. Staff are unable to reapply sunscreen so if possible please apply the long lasting cream at the start of the day.
