Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the summer term. The children are already working incredibly hard and we know how successful they are going to be this term. Please take the time to read this letter carefully as it includes information about our upcoming learning and the events and trips for the rest of the term.



This term's topic is *Rivers*, giving us many opportunities for exploring the humanities. In Geography this term, we will study British rivers and rivers of the World, learning about the stages of a river course and the water cycle. We will complete a local study piece of Box Hill and the River Mole, using the area as a focus for our map work, before visiting it to complete a field work study. In Science this term, we will learning about Light and getting outdoors as much as possible to see the Science we are learning in action. This will really encourage scientific enquiry and give a real life focus to our investigations.

PE is twice weekly outdoors and over the term we will learn and practice cricket alongside a range of athletic skills. Throughout, there will be an emphasis on physical fitness and the enjoyment of physical activity. The children will have the opportunity to compete in athletics at Sports Day and at some will be selected for District Sports. Please ensure that your child has a full PE kit in school as we often struggle because children do not have the equipment they need.



Year 6 will take centre stage in this year's production, with all pupils taking part as part of their learning after SATs. The performances will take place on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July and Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July from 6pm. Alongside acting and singing roles, there will be exciting opportunities to get involved behind the scenes, including props, lighting and music, ensuring every child plays a valuable part.

Can we ask that everyone supports us to keep the children looking smart and in the correct uniform. They are not allowed to wear trainers to school, or fashion leggings for PE. Your help would be gratefully received.
